THE REFEREE

- Referees give directives to players, blow whistles, & on occasion administer consequences for a breach of the rules, but NEVER scream at or lecture players.
- Referees NEVER ridicule players from the sideline. They run with players, are keenly involved in play, & observe every move in non-invasive ways. If a referee sees a foul, they call it as they see it & stand by their decision.
- Changing decisions promotes chaos on the field, & stirs the crowd (referees get lynched). Incorrect decisions can always be reviewed & discussed after the game.

THE REFEREE

- There are always 2 referees on the field: One running with players & one on the sideline. Referees always respect & back each other up no matter what (even if they disagree, they never let on in front of players).
- If referees openly disagree, players take sides & fighting breaks out. Players lose respect for referees, for each other, & for the game. Loss of respect is terminal. In the absence of respect, referees totally lose control of the match. The degree respect referees have towards each other is reflected in the degree of control they have over the game.

BOUNDARIES

Rules before relationship = **Rebellion/Resentment**

Relationship before rules = **Respect**

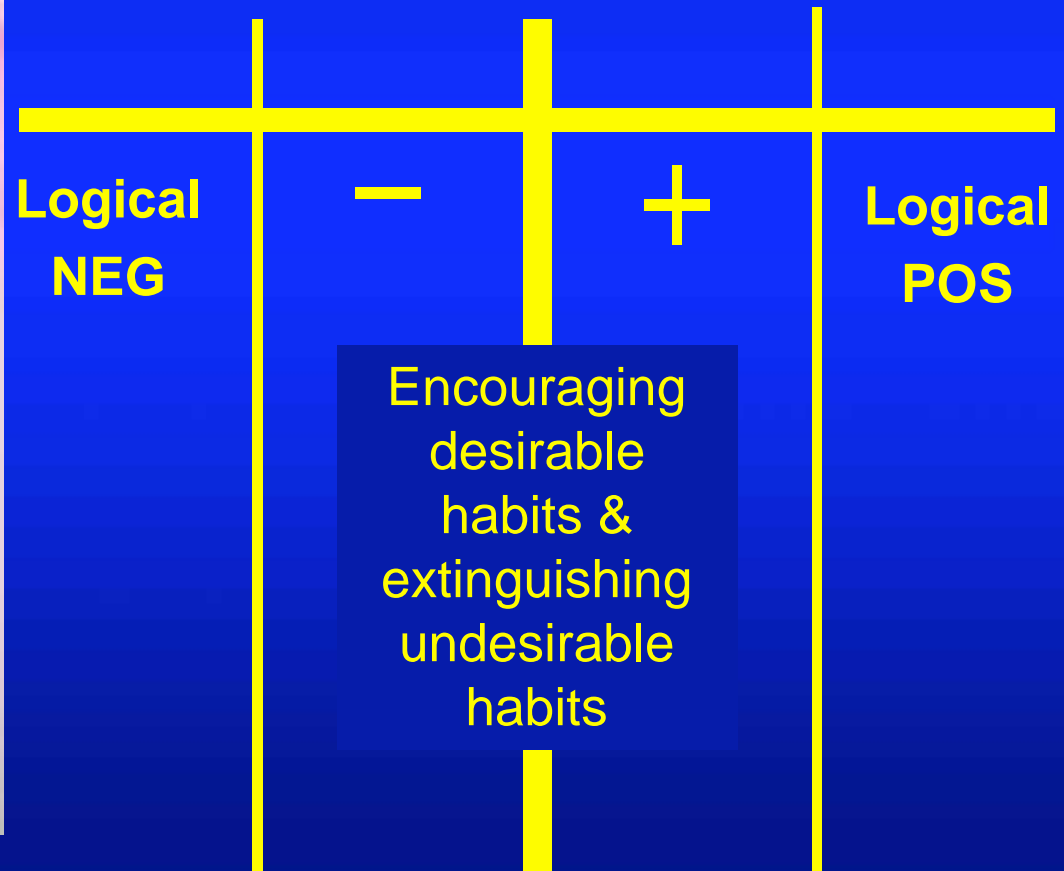
Rules should help us to have fun (not destroy it - soccer)

There are always two different sets of rules:

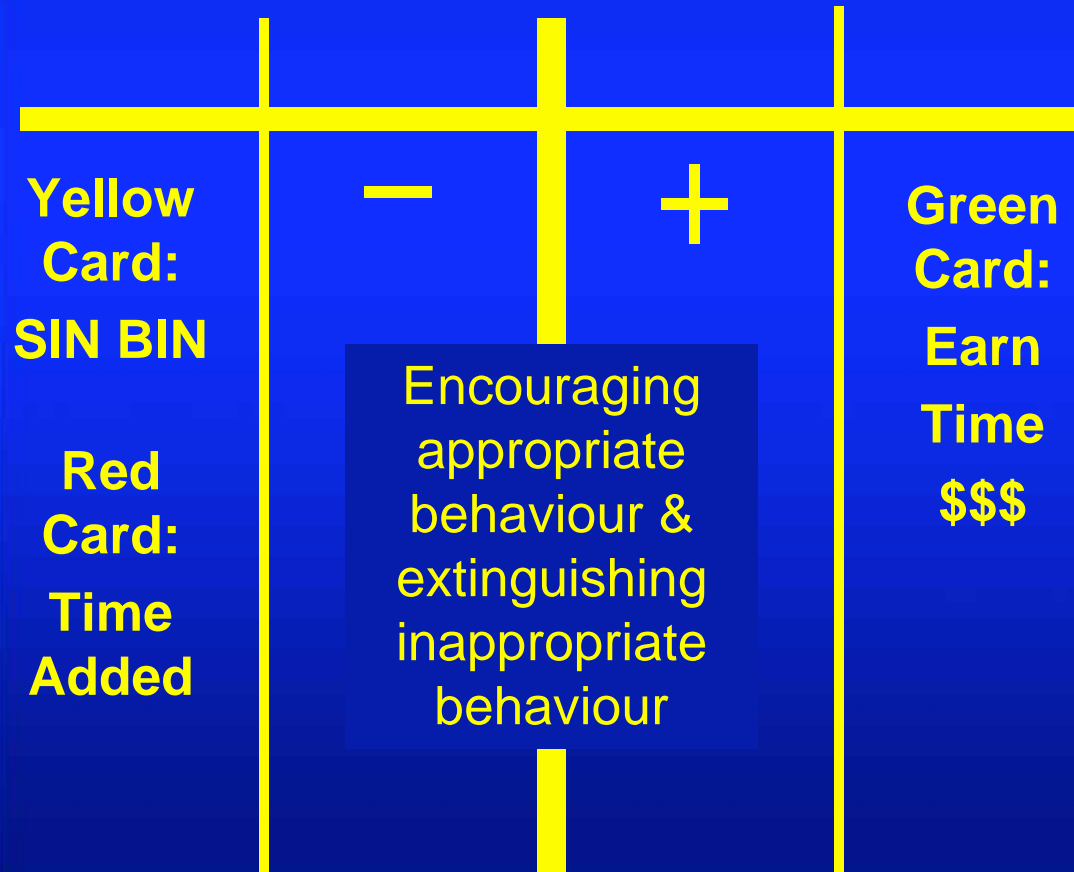
- **Incidental rules** (kicking the ball out of bounds)
